INFORMATION BULLETIN No.1

To: ALL IDBF MEMBERS AND NON-MEMBER DRAGON BOAT ORGANISATIONS.

The Organizing Committee of “Macau 2010” the 7th IDBF Club Crew World Championships (Macau 2010 CCWC) in conjunction with the International Dragon Boat Federation (IDBF) cordially invite Club Crews from around the world to participate in the Championships, which will be held from Wednesday 28 July to Sunday 1 August, 2010, at the Nam Van Lake Nautical Center, Macao S.A.R. China

OUTLINE PROGRAMME: The programme is provisional and is to assist crews with their planning.

The Opening ceremony will take place on the evening of 28 July 2010. Wednesday 28th July 2010, will be the reserve racing day in the event that the number of crews racing necessitates an extra day's racing.

Competing crews are advised to arrive Macao no later than Tuesday 27 July 2010 but crews arriving earlier will be catered for.





COMPETITION REGULATION AND RACING RULES

The Macau 2010 CCWC will comply with the IDBF Competition Regulations and will be conducted under the IDBF Rules of Racing. **All participating crews are required to return a completed Provisional Entry Form to IDBF with a copy to the Macao Organizing Committee by no later than 14th January 2010.**

DIVISIONS, RACING & COMPETITION CLASSES

The Championships that will be contested are listed below provided sufficient entries are received in each competition class. Entries from up to five (5) crews per competition class, per Country or Territory, will be allowed.

New for this CCWC and to encourage entries from developing Clubs there will be Small Boat Races over 200m and 500m only, for Open, Women and Mixed Crews. Crews may enter either the Standard Boat Races or the Small Boat Races but NOT both. (Small Boat Mixed Crew is a min of 4 and max of 6 women paddlers)

A minimum of six (6) different IDBF Members are required for a competition class to be given world championship status. A minimum of three (3) IDBF Members per competition class are required to qualify for IDBF Championship status.

Age Regulations:- Seniors: A - Over 40. **Senior B** (Grand Dragons): over 50 as of 1 June 2010.

Junior: A - Under 18 but 12 or over. **Junior B** Under 16 but 12 or over as 1 January 2010.

Under 23s - Under 23 but 18 or over as at 1 Jan 2010. 6 crew members may be U18 – Small Boat 3.

BCS DIVISION. BCS Crews may also take part in a BCS Division with Championship Medals

ENTRIES.

Each crew's entry to the 2010 CCWC must be sanctioned, by the IDBF Member Organisation to which that crews belongs, where one exists. Crews from countries or Territories where there is not an IDBF Member may compete subject to the agreement of the IDBF Executive Committee.

All Entries are to be sent to IDBF directly, with all administrative information and returns going to the Macao 2010 CCWC Organizing Committee.

REGATTA FEES

An IDBF Registration Fee of USD 10:00 per person is to be paid by all participants. **For this CCWC no Administration Fee will be charged by the Organizing Committee.**





ACCOMMODATION AND LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee of Macau 2010 CCWC have made arrangements for a choice of accommodation packages, ranging from **USD 50 to USD 140** per person per day, which will include:

- 6 nights Accommodation (Bed & Breakfast) in a choice of three-star to five-star Hotels,
- Arrival/Departure Transport Service (one trip on arrival and one trip on departure, per competing Crew),
- Transport between Official Hotel and Competition Site, during training days and racing days,
- Transportation between Official Hotel and Celebration Dinner.

The complete list of official hotels and package prices will be available in Information Bulletin N^o2, after the Provisional Entries have been processed.

Participants are entitled to make their own arrangements, but races will not be delayed for crews that are not staying in the officials hotels or travel under private arrangements.

RACE DAY LUNCHES

Lunches will be available to all competitors and their coaches, managers and registered supporters at the competition site, various menus will be provided in the price range of USD 10 – 22 per set.

CELEBRATION DINNER

A complementary Celebration Dinner Party will be provided for all competitors and their coaches, managers and registered supporters but the total number of participants, per Club, must be given to the Macau 2010 CCWC Organizing Committee by 3rd May 2010, with a Club's Confirmed Entry.

PAYMENTS

IDBF Registration Fees are to be paid directly to the IDBF Treasurer with the Named Entries.

Other payments, excluding the balance of accommodation costs, are to be made to the Macau 2010 Organizing Committee by electronic transfer in US Dollars no later than the relevant deadline.
